The role involves:

- working across a range of family scenarios which may include working with adults and/or parents and younger carers
- ensuring that family carers of all ages are able to access a range of health & wellbeing support, to include those that do not recognise themselves as carers
- being welcoming and accessible to vulnerable adults and people who have a disability
- providing support to all age family carers from the age of 5 years old
- Oversee the organisation of youth club
- working with other agencies where required to aim to reduce caring roles of children and young people
- completing a range of Family Carers Assessments
- facilitating and developing connections to statutory and voluntary agencies
